Subject: **TUITION AND OTHER SCHOOL FEES  
FOR SY 2021-2022**

As SY 2020-2021 draws to a close, we would expect that many would like to be advised ahead of their tuition and other school fees for the coming school year.

As you may know, we conducted a consultation meeting last May 11, 2021 with the representatives of the different sectors of the school on the subject of TOSFI<sup>1</sup> which was approved by CHED on April 13, 2020. You may recall that notwithstanding the approval, we have deferred its implementation for the old students this school year, mindful how the pandemic has financially affected our students and their families. Along with the deferral of the TOSFI, we have also limited the collection of miscellaneous fees to the very few essentials with a considerably lower rate.

Despite these financial adjustments, the school has made it as a priority to acquire a new Learning Management System (LMS), the Blackboard Learn™ Ultra, to ensure that the learning of our students is not impaired.

We are pleased to note that while even at the height of the pandemic, our students continue to receive equal access to learning through such platform. Students' use of Blackboard Learn™ was made without charge, with free mobile data connection worth ₱300.00 for five (5) months to guarantee seamless instruction.

We have also made sure that the livelihood of our employees is not, in any way, endangered. We have endeavored to preserve and secure their employment this whole pandemic and have, so far, successfully kept our workforce intact.

However, just like many schools, we have not been spared by the economic pressures created by the pandemic. Thus, our proposal to implement the CHED-approved TOSFI for SY 2021-2022 and the introduction of an LMS fee to cover the school's subscription to Blackboard Learn™.

But while we see the overriding need for a TOSFI at this time, recognizing the challenges many of us continue to experience is also crucially important to the school.

With that said, it is the decision of the school that:

- 1] **Implementation of the tuition fee increase shall only begin on the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of SY 2021-2022;**
- 2] Increase in other school fees shall commence on the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of SY 2021-2022;
- 3] Collection of miscellaneous fees shall remain limited to the necessary minimum and will continue to be under a reduced rate for as long as we are on a remote mode of learning.
- 4] Surcharges for unsettled balances are waived.

To the whole community, rest assured that the best interest and welfare of everyone shall remain to be our primary commitment.
